REGION Southern Rhône. Rasteau.

EXPOSITION South hillsides, slightly protected from the mistral.



SOIL COMPOSITION Gray and blue clay.

GRAPE COMPOSITION 80 % Grenache, 10 % Mouvèdre, 10 % Syrah.

VINE AGE 70 years old.

DENSITY 3 000 vines per HA

HARVEST TYPE Hand Picked.



VINIFICATION 30 days fermentation and maceration in concrete tank.

MALOLACTIC – YES/NO No.

ALCOHOL PERCENTAGE 14 %.

RESIDUAL SUGAR Less than 2 grams per litre.

NUMBER OF BOTTLES PRODUCED 50 000 bottles.



TASTING NOTES

Bright, vibrant black and red fruits linger on the middle palate, herbs of Provence, spice box and a slightly peppery finish.



FOOD PAIRING Braised, slow cooked lamb shanks, white wine Provençal rabbit, goats cheese, ratatouille and grilled meats, eye fillet with pepper sauce.
